Probably a major issue was the sale of the manse which lately had become a concern for the session, especially the operations committee. The sale is complete, and we are no longer landlords dealing with tenants! The church, under the direction of Mike and Susan Henwood, provided thousands of weekend breakfasts for Bremen Elementary School students, shawls were made by members of the church for local shut-ins, money and support was provided for the Bremen Area Food Pantry, the Ackermans continue their work with materials for shut-ins, lunch was prepared by the service committee for the Bremen Area Chamber of Commerce, Vacation Bible School was presented in cooperation with other local churches, etc., etc. I know I have missed other activities of the church, but I am doing this from memory.

Session will be reorganizing later in January with newly elected elders, Class of '26. Returning to service are Susan Henwood, Gene McCandlish and Linda Shreyer .
