FROM THE CLERK OF SESSION: Dee Mowry

I often hear about Bremen-Bethel being 'a small poor' church. Let's set the record straight, which is important in the world today with so much 'disinformation.' Bremen-Bethel belongs to the Scioto Valley Presbytery which includes 86 churches with a total membership of 12,817 (as of March 20, 2023,) the latest available statistics from Scioto Valley. The presbytery is dominated by the urban center of Columbus, OH and extends from Marion in the north, east to Newark, west to London and southward, through the central part of the state, to the Ohio River. We are on the fringe of the southern portion of the presbytery, which is distinguished by an Appalachian culture, which includes many small towns and much rugged open country. Bremen-Bethel is also in the Synod of the Covenant which extends from the Upper Peninsula of Michigan to Northern Kentucky. Back to Scioto Valley Presbytery, individual church membership in the presbytery ranges from 1,399 members (10.7% of presbytery membership, Bremen-Bethel represents .004% of Presbytery membership) to 8 members.

In Fairfield County, there are 6 Presbyterian Churches, Bremen-Bethel is the second largest. The Columbus area has 16 Presbyterian Churches, 7 of these churches have fewer members than Bremen-Bethel. A lot has been noted about membership numbers, this is important because our per capita cost is figured on reported members. This per capita figure currently stands at \$40.00 per member (Bremen-Bethel is always up-to-date with our per capita contributions.) The per capita dollar(s) is the figure that the church pays to support the higher adjudicators, that is, presbytery, synod and general assembly. The Book of Order mandates that the church membership be reviewed annually, this is accomplished by the Mission Committee of the church session and, as a result, our membership number is up-to-date.

The church is on very firm financial ground as session a few years ago opened an equity account at the Stifel Nicolaus Brokerage Company. The gain over the years has averaged about \$1,000.00 per month. \$35,000.00 was withdrawn to handle some church expenses, this amount has been replaced by the market at a very favorable rate. The treasurer is able to provide firm figures regarding the investment portfolio as well as the church investment committee. This committee consists of the session Operations Committee, the assistant treasurer and the clerk of session.

Major improvements have been made to the church building and the grounds recently. These improvements have been made possible because of the generosity of the members of Bremen-Bethel and favorable investment returns.

There are currently 12 households participating in our Kroger Community Rewards. For the quarter of February through April, we received \$43.94. The session has designated the income to the *Breakfast to Go* program.
